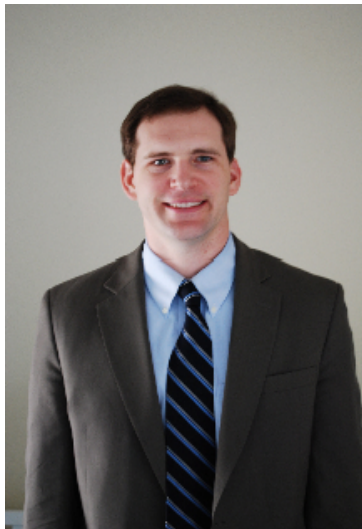


## VESTRY NOMINEES 2009
